### The Green Festival, Ludlow

The centre-piece is a bustling green fair in the Castle Square, organised by Ludlow 21. In addition, there are several other events, live music and entertainment from 10-4pm

### The Sun Inn Beer and Music Festival

An annual beer festival with great music organised by Big String Music of Ludlow; superb selection of local beers and ciders plus a hog roast adds to the warm atmosphere of the event, hosted in the garden of the historic parlour pub.

### Other Places of interest .....

The bus also passes by the historic church of Pipe Aston and the ancient settlement of Wigmore where you can visit the medieval home of the Mortimer family, Wigmore Castle. There's also a concert at Leintwardine church at 4.30 pm on Sunday 28th August-part of the Presteigne Festival of Music and Arts
