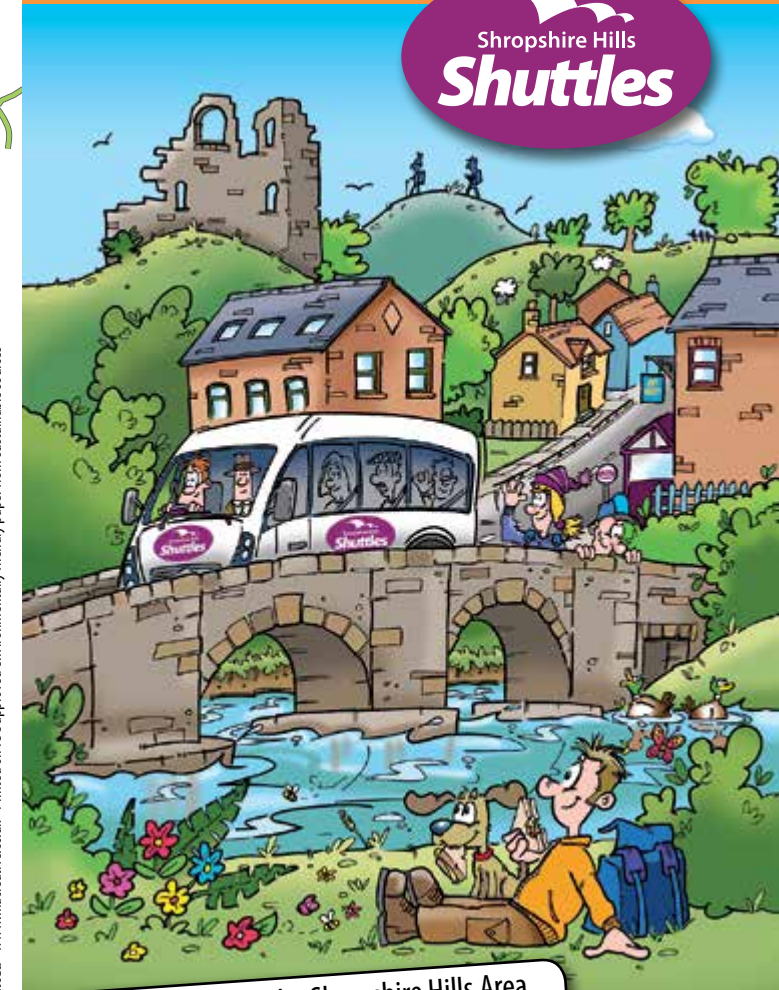

Enjoy a day out!

Ludlow – With nearly 500 listed buildings, a Norman castle, original medieval streets and a lively market square there is plenty to keep you busy. Enjoy a walk along the River Teme and lunch in one of the many excellent cafés and restaurants. www.theludlowguide.co.uk

Bromfield – Take a leisurely stroll back to Ludlow following the Shropshire Way. Ludlow Food Centre and café a two minute walk from this stop.

Leintwardine – A picturesque village on the River Teme, which has a pub, hotel, restaurant, local shop and fish 'n chip shop. Walk to Bucknell following the way marked Walking with Offa, route 12.

Brampton Bryan – A warm welcome awaits at the Aardvark bookshop and café, open at weekends from 10am.

Bucknell – Choice of Walking with Offa routes to follow – walk to Knighton or Leintwardine, or enjoy the circular way marked walks. Two pubs and two shops in the village.

Knighton – Or Tref-y-Clawdd (town on the Dyke). Explore the winding streets known locally as 'The Narrows'. King Offa's 8th century earthwork is explained at the Offa's Dyke Visitor Centre or better still see it for yourself and walk some of the trail which follows it.

Clun – Clun gathers you in. It is the perfect spot for a picnic by the river, or treat yourself to a local lunch. Explore the medieval castle, follow the heritage trail and enjoy a riverside ramble.

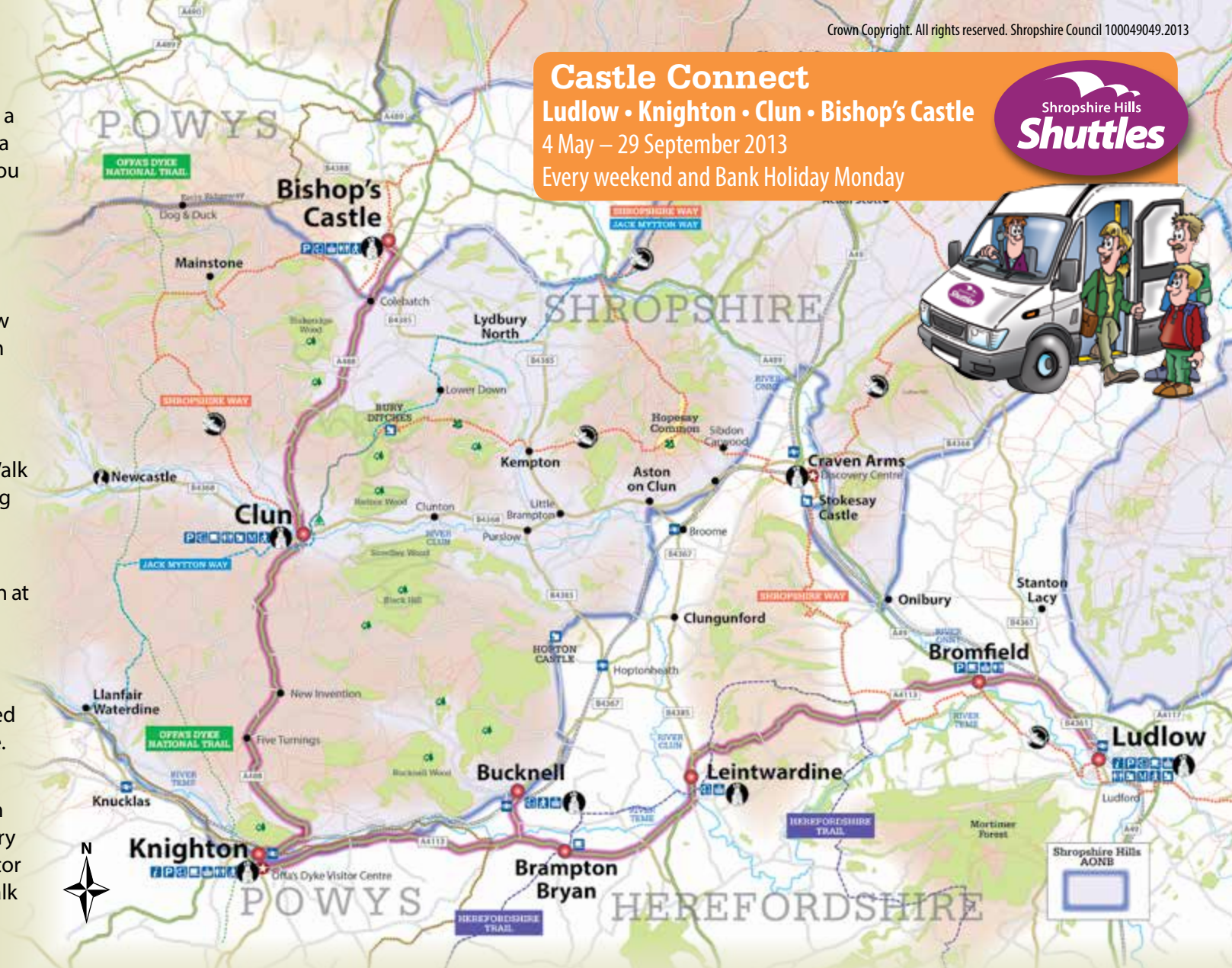
